



## Holy Trail Route Instructions

### 7.4 Mile Loop Route

The route begins in Waltham Village. A large village and civil parish in North East Lincolnshire. It is 4 miles south of Grimsby.

**START** on the footpath at lamp post 13 in front of All Saints Church on the High Street in Waltham, Grimsby DN37 0PN.

**Parking:** There is a small car park opposite and plenty of other parking in the village.

**Bus Routes:** There are bus stops a few metres walk away on the High Street in Waltham.

**What3words for the START** is: [///prom.canny.basis](https://www.what3words.com/prom.canny.basis) - This will also be your **FINISH**.

**Please note: Arrows on pictures are shown for route direction.**



**START** - On this route you will visit 4 Churches. Starting in front of your first Church head towards the Zebra Crossing and turn **RIGHT** down Church Lane. At the bottom of this road turn **RIGHT** onto Skinners Lane, then turn **LEFT** onto Cheapside.

When safe to do so, cross over the road to the opposite footpath. You will go past the junction of Mill View on your right-hand side. You will then see a Public Footpath on your right-hand side. Turn **RIGHT** and head up the track. You will eventually turn **RIGHT** through the back of the Windmill site. Head through the car park towards Brigsley Road. Turn **LEFT** onto the footpath at Brigsley road.

Head straight along this footpath until you see a footpath sign, turn **LEFT** here through a small cutting. Continue all the way through and you will exit on Waltham Road. Continue straight ahead on the left-hand side footpath, keep going and head straight ahead. At the bend continue straight ahead and down Church Lane into Brigsley Village. You will see the second of 4 Churches on your left-hand side – St Helens Church.

At the bottom of Church Lane turn RIGHT onto Waithe Lane. You will see a thatched cottage on your right-hand side, opposite the cottage is a Public Footpath, turn LEFT down here on the tarmac footpath. Go over the small wooden bridge crossing Waithe Beck, then take the LEFT footpath through the centre of a field.

Across this field you will cross another small wooden bridge. Head straight over the bridge and through the tunnel of trees until you come to a gate. Go through the gate and head straight ahead on the track, keeping the hedge to your left-hand side.

At the bottom of this straight stretch follow the public footpath and keep heading straight ahead, keeping the hedge line on your right-hand side (see pic below). At the bottom of this hedge line, you will see a Footpath sign on your right-hand side just before the next field begins. Turn SHARP RIGHT here over the wooden bridge and head diagonally across the field (see pic below).



Once across the field turn LEFT along a track towards Main Road in Ashby cum Fenby. At the road turn RIGHT onto Main Road. It is a quiet lane with no footpath so beware of traffic.

Follow this lane until you see it veering sharp left at a bend. Here turn RIGHT and head towards the third Church called **St Peters Church**.

At the footpath leading to the Church, turn **completely** around heading back towards the junction you have just turned off. Turn RIGHT at this junction and continue following the lane through the village.

Stay on this lane until you come to another Public Footpath sign on your right-hand side, turn RIGHT and head across the field keeping the hedge line to your right-hand side.

You will eventually come back to the bridge across Waithe Beck that you crossed earlier. Go over the bridge and head back on the tarmac to Waithe Lane. Here turn LEFT in front of the thatched cottage.

Head down the lane to the junction and carefully cross over Waltham Road. You will see a Public Footpath that goes straight ahead to the right-hand side of the house though some gates (the house used to be an ice-cream shop).

Follow this footpath which takes you through some woods. As you exit the first set of woods head straight ahead until you come to another junction in the path. Turn RIGHT, then next LEFT. You will be heading straight ahead to another set of woods.

Go all the way through the woods, following the track until you exit at Barnoldy le Beck Village.

Turn **RIGHT** and cross over the road safely and head down Church Lane where you will see the 4<sup>th</sup> of your Churches. Turn **RIGHT** in front of the Church and then **RIGHT** again onto Chapel Lane.

Take you next **LEFT** turn onto Old Main Road. Follow this road around to the main road. Turn **LEFT** onto Waltham Road.

Stay on this footpath heading straight ahead for over a mile into Waltham Village. Staying straight ahead, safely cross over a mini roundabout and continue straight all the way to the bottom of this road.

You will eventually come to your 3<sup>rd</sup> mini roundabout at Waltham High Street.

Turn **LEFT** and head straight ahead, crossing over a junction and passing the car park in front of the shops on your left-hand side. You will see All Saints Church to your right. Head towards the Zebra Crossing and cross over to the church where you started. - This is your **FINISH**.

**MAP OF ROUTE** – Please note that small stickers/discs will help guide you around the route.
