



Humba Rumba Route Instructions

7km Loop Route

The route starts from the Humber Yacht Club car park at the back of the Humberston Fitties, North East Lincolnshire, DN36 4EZ. The Humber Yacht Club is located at the mouth of the River Humber on the south bank close to Cleethorpes.

START: At the public footpath sign on the right as you enter the car park.

Parking: There is a car park at the Yacht Club

Bus Routes: There are bus stops about 25 minutes' walk away at the bottom of North Sea Lane close to the Beachcomber site.

What3words for the START is: *///smashes.gather.folds* - This will also be your **FINISH**.

Please note: Arrows on pictures are shown for route direction.



START at the public footpath sign that is on the right-hand side as you enter the car park. Keeping the coastline behind you and the large pond to your left-hand side, head out along the track towards the raised bank. Turn LEFT onto the bank and follow this track for around a mile and half. You will pass various concrete bunkers and go underneath a large pipeline.

Once at the end of this grassed track turn RIGHT onto the gravel track. Head straight ahead, keeping the Louth Canal to your left-hand side. The gravel track will veer right, here you need to head straight ahead onto the grassed track following the public footpath sign and keeping the canal to your left-hand side.

Continue ahead to the next public footpath sign, you will come to a road at a corner, here you need to turn RIGHT onto Newton Marsh Lane.

Stay on this lane for about 1 mile until it veers left. Keep straight ahead here following the footpath sign through a set of large gates. Then take a RIGHT turn and follow the footpath ALL the way up to the bank ahead of you.

You will cross over a wooden bridge. At the top of the bank turn LEFT heading back on the same route you started on. At the bottom of this track turn RIGHT. Keep going straight ahead with pond on your right-hand side and FINISH where you started.

MAP OF ROUTE – Please note small stickers/discs will help guide you around the route.
