



Leggit Loop Route Instructions

4.8 miles

This route is close to Beelsby village in North East Lincolnshire, England. The village is situated approximately 6 miles south-west from Grimsby (see map below).

The **START** of the route is at a kissing gate about halfway down on the road between Beelsby and Swallow/Irby Road Junction. This route can be accessed via the A46 or the A18.

Parking: There is plenty of space to park up on the grass verges.

Bus Routes: There are no bus stops close to this route.

What3words for the START is: [///magazines.torched.fragments](https://www.what3words.com////magazines.torched.fragments) - This will also be your **FINISH**.

Please note: Arrows on pictures are shown for route direction.



Start the route by going through the kissing gate and walk towards the hedge keeping it on your right-hand side. Head straight ahead all the way to the gravel track where you turn LEFT.

Stay on the gravel track as it veers right. Enjoy the glorious views of the Humber as you head straight ahead. The track will eventually veer left.

You will pass a Public Footpath sign on your left, do NOT go through it. Keep going and eventually you will come to a barrier, turn LEFT up a small hill – this is Walk Lane.



Follow Walk Lane as it undulates up and down. You will pass 2 houses on your left-hand side. Continue on this lane. You will eventually come to Public Footpath sign on your LEFT to go through a gap in the hedge. Go left through this and follow the footpath all the way towards the Irby Holmes Woods. Just prior to the woods follow the footpath to the RIGHT, then immediate LEFT. Follow this track all the way to the end and turn LEFT into the woods.

Go straight through the woods all the way to the bottom and head straight out the other side. Follow this track until you come to another Footpath sign at a gap in the hedge on your RIGHT. Go through this gap and turn immediately RIGHT.

You are now back on the track that you came down on. Follow the track as it veers right. Stay on the track as it passes the woods on your right-hand side across the field. Keep going until the path veers left.

Turn RIGHT at the grass track that you first came along. Head straight ahead back to the kissing gate where you started.

This is your **FINISH**.
